**ORDER ON PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR
RECONSIDERATION AND REHEARING**

On January 10, 2020, the New Hampshire Board of Medicine ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order finding and ruling that Jayakumar Patil, M.D. ("Dr. Patil") committed professional misconduct in his treatment of patient C.C. from February 8, 2017 to May 23, 2018. The Board found that Dr. Patil committed seven acts of misconduct, and, given Dr. Patil's history of frequent discipline by this Board, revoked his license, effective thirty days from the date of the Order. On February 7, 2020, the Board granted a stay of the revocation through March 30, 2020.

Now before the Board is Petitioner's Motion for Reconsideration and Rehearing, dated February 10, 2020, submitted by Dr. Patil's attorney Christina A. Ferrari, Esq. The motion asks the Board to "reconsider and reverse its January 10, 2020 Final Order and Decision ("Order"), revoking his license to practice medicine, and commence a rehearing on the claim(s) in this matter and the proper measure of disciplinary action." Hearing Counsel in this matter, Sheri Phillips, Esq., filed an objection to the motion for reconsideration and rehearing, dated March 2, 2020.

After careful review of Dr. Patil's motion and Hearing Counsel's objection, the Board GRANTS Petitioner's Motion for Reconsideration and Rehearing IN PART, as follows.

To the extent Dr. Patil's motion seeks reconsideration and reversal of the Board's findings that he committed seven acts of misconduct in violation of RSA 329:17, VI, the motion is DENIED.


To the extent Dr. Patil's motion seeks a rehearing on the issue of the proper measure of disciplinary action under RSA 329:17, VII, the motion is GRANTED.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The stay of the revocation of Dr. Patil's license will continue pending a rehearing on the issue of the proper measure of disciplinary action;
2. Dr. Patil's prescriptions will be honored until such time as the Board issues an order following rehearing;
3. Dr. Patil will continue his monitoring with Leonard Korn, M.D.; and
4. Dr. Patil will not accept any new patients.
