VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF REGISTRATION

Recognizing that professional misconduct allegations are now pending against me before the New Hampshire Board of Pharmacy (“Board”) I, Caitlin Taylor, PhT, hereby agree to a voluntary surrender of my New Hampshire registration (#PhT-125458), effective upon the date that the Board accepts this offer of voluntary surrender as settlement of the misconduct allegations pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. R Ph 402.03.

By voluntarily surrendering my Pharmacy Technician Registration, I understand that:

1. I relinquish all rights and privileges to practice as a Pharmacy Technician in the State of New Hampshire, effective the date that I sign this document.
2. The Board had commenced an investigation pursuant to RSA 318:30, and a Notice of Hearing was issued by the Board on August 18, 2022.
3. I admit that this *Voluntary Surrender of Registration* has occurred in settlement of the pending misconduct allegations outlined in the Notice of Hearing referenced in paragraph 2 of this *Voluntary Surrender of Registration*.
4. I admit to no violations of any State statutes, rules, or ethical provision, but recognize that the fact that my *Voluntary Surrender of Registration* will be distributed by the Board as a disciplinary action.

5. I understand that this *Voluntary Surrender of Registration* shall be distributed to all relevant licensing authorities and professional societies in the same manner as a final decision-making specific finding of professional misconduct.
6. I understand that this *Voluntary Surrender of Registration* shall become a permanent part of my file and will be maintained by the Board as a public document.
7. I understand that should I again seek licensure by this Board, I must meet, and shall bear the burden of proving compliance with, all standards and prerequisites then required by the Board for new applicants, including all professional character requirements.
8. I further understand that the above referenced pending misconduct allegations shall be addressed at a Show Cause Hearing before the Board prior to submitting any future licensure application at which I shall have the burden of proof. These misconduct allegations may then form the basis for the Board to deny any such application. I hereby specifically waive any statute of limitations or laches defense, which might then be available as to these misconduct allegations, including but not limited to, those contained in RSA 332-G:8 and 9. I further waive any issues of a speedy hearing or spoliation of evidence.
9. I voluntarily submit this *Voluntary Surrender of Registration* to the Board and state that no promises or representation have been made to me other than those terms and conditions expressly stated herein.


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10. I have had the opportunity to seek and obtain the advice of an attorney of my choosing in connection with my decision to sign this *Voluntary Surrender of Registration*.


