Board of Chiropractic Examiners Emergency Public Meeting Minutes February 28, 2022

An emergency meeting of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners was called to order on February 25, 2022, at 2:01 p.m. with the following Board members present:

Motion to move into non-public session:

On motion at 2:02 p.m. of LP, seconded by DP, the Board voted to conduct a non-public session for the purpose of discussing investigations of alleged licensee misconduct and other confidential Board business and noting that such a non-public session is authorized by RSA 91-A:3, II (c), RSA 91-A:3 II (e), RSA 91-A:5, IV, RSA 316:22, RSA 316:23-a, Lodge v. Knowlton, 119 N.H. 574 (1978), and the Board's executive and deliberative privileges.

Motion to keep minutes of non-public session confidential:

Upon the motion by LP, with a second by DL, the Board voted to withhold and seal the minutes of the preceding non-public session from public disclosure pursuant to RSA 91-A: 3 III, that divulgence of the information likely would affect adversely the reputation of a person other than a Board member and to render the proposed action ineffective. Each member recorded his or her vote on the motion, which passed by the unanimous vote of all members present.

Emergency Hearing:

The Matter of Dr. Clarence Meyer, D.C. –

Upon a motion by LP, with a second by DP, the Board voted to emergently suspend the license of Dr. Clarence Meyer due to evidence that Dr. Meyer poses an imminent threat to the public's safety, and welfare. Motion passed via unanimous roll call vote.
