**The American Board of Dental Examiners (ADEX) stopped offering live patient testing as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, relying on manikin testing instead.**

**Without the enactment of this emergency rule, applicants who have taken the ADEX examination in 2020 or 2021 are unlikely to qualify for a dental hygienist license in New Hampshire because they will be unable to fulfill the clinical procedure component. This will exacerbate the current shortage of dental hygienists in the State, creating an immediate peril to public health.**

**The NH Board of Dental Examiners, at their July 12, 2021, voted unanimously to approve an Emergency Rule that would allow the Board/Office of Professional Licensure and Certification to accept ADEX results for those who took the ADEX exam in 2020 or 2021; in other words, those who took the manikin ADEX exam.**

9. A summary of the effect if the rule were not adopted.

**If this rule were not adopted, dental hygiene applicants who had taken the ADEX exam in 2020 or 2021 would not qualify for a license in New Hampshire. This would cause unnecessary unemployment and prevent the State from recruiting newly-graduated students who wished to become licensed with the Dental Board.**

10. A description of those affected.

**This rule affects dental hygienist applicants, business owners who are seeking credentialed dental hygienists, and members of the public who would be delayed in or unable to secure services.**

**Amend Den 301.01(a)(8), effective 12/6/17 (Document #12428) so that Den 301.01 (a) intro, and (a)(8) are cited and read as follows:**

Den 301.01 Application for Dental Hygienist Licensure.

(a) Each applicant for a license to practice dental hygiene in the state of New Hampshire shall provide the following on the "Dental Hygienist Application for Licensure" form:

(8) Whether the applicant has taken and passed the examinations of the:

a. Joint Commission on National Dental Examinations; and

b. American Board of Dental Examiners (ADEX) dental hygiene examination or other similar U.S. regional or state board including clinical procedure components and/or manikin examination for applications submitted since the end of the state of emergency (June 12, 2021);
