A person not a resident of and having no established place of business in this state who wishes to practice or offer to practice the profession of Land Surveying in this state may make application to the Board on this form for a temporary certificate to practice, provided such person is licensed in his/her own state or country in which the requirements and qualifications for obtaining a certificate of licensure are substantially equivalent to or greater than those specified in this chapter. Upon written approval of the application by the Chairman and the Secretary, the applicant shall be authorized to practice the profession of Land Surveying in this state, limited to such periods as shall be determined by the Board, but may not exceed an aggregate of 30 days in one calendar year. Any portion of a day shall be counted as a whole day.

Upon receipt and Board approval you will be issued a temporary permit number.

Upon completion of the specified project, you will submit the plans to be recorded and a blue line or zerox copy to this office bearing your out of state stamp and signature. The Board will then stamp this permit and your plans to be recorded in the registry with the **TEMPORARY STAMP PERMIT**.
