PUBLIC SESSION

<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: Olivia Freeman called the meeting to order at 10:09 AM.

APPROVAL OF THE FEBRUARY 28, 2022, PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES:

Traci Johnson moved to accept the 2/28/2022 public meeting minutes as amended, and Pat Gruttemeyer seconded; the motion passed. Nicole Quartulli abstained.

OT COMPACT:

The Board reviewed the "Winter 2021 2022 State Affairs Newsletter" from the OT Compact. Olivia Freeman noted that Utah and Washington had just joined the Compact, and so far, it was only New Hampshire and Maine representing New England in the Compact. Olivia Freeman explained that Massachusetts would not be joining as they did not have stringent CEU requirements for renewal. Olivia Freeman also noted that the topic of dry needling would be coming up in the future. The Board discussed the fact that their current practice act does not mention dry needling, and that PAMS covered dry needling.
