VOLUNTARY SURRENDER

The New Hampshire Board of Psychologists (“Board”) first granted Jeffrey Kay, PhD. (“Dr. Kay” or “Respondent”) a license to practice as a Psychologist in the State of New Hampshire on January 1, 1996. Dr. Kay was issued license number 786, set to expire June 30, 2021.

The Board received an allegation the Board determined warranted a complaint, alleging Dr. Kay violated section(s) Chapter 329-B.


Respondent enters into a Voluntary Surrender of Licensure in the State of New Hampshire as follows:

1. Recognizing that professional misconduct allegations are now pending against me before the Board, I, Jeffrey Kay, PhD. voluntarily agree to surrender my license to practice as a New Hampshire licensed Psychologist effective six (6) weeks after execution of this agreement by the Board.
2. I admit to no violations of NH Chapter RSA 329-B or any administrative rules, ethical provisions, or any other laws, statutes, or regulations, adopted by the Board.

3. I admit that this license surrender has occurred in settlement of a pending misconduct complaint.
4. Understanding that this Voluntary Surrender of licensure and the restrictions herein shall remain until further order of the Board, I hereby specifically waive any statute of limitations, or laches defense, which might be then available, including but not limited to, those based on RSA 332-G: 8 and RSA 332-G: 9.
5. In the event that I apply for a reinstatement of my license while this agreement is in effect, I voluntarily agree to waive any statutory or administrative time deadlines regarding the Board's final action on any such license reinstatement application. I understand that by waiving such deadlines, the Board's final action on any such license reinstatement application will be automatically deferred until after the disposition of this Board matter.
6. I further understand that the pending disciplinary allegations shall be resolved before any future licensure reinstatement application I may submit in New Hampshire is approved.
7. I enter into this Voluntary Surrender with the Board and state that no promises or representations have been made to me other than those terms and conditions expressly stated herein.
8. I understand that this document shall become a permanent part of my file, and will be maintained by the Board as a public document.


9. I understand that if the Board chooses to accept my surrender of licensure, this document shall be distributed to all relevant licensing authorities in the same manner as a final decision making specific findings of professional misconduct
10. I have had the opportunity to seek and obtain the advice of an attorney of my choosing in connection with my decision to sign this Voluntary Surrender.
11. I am of sound mind and not under the influence of any substance that would impair my judgement at the time I sign this Voluntary Surrender.
12. I understand that my failure to comply with the terms of this Voluntary Surrender shall constitute unprofessional conduct and may subject me to discipline under Chapter RSA 329-B.
