3. “State Occupational Licensing Review and Reform”; Peter Danles, Director of OPLC obtained a grant to review and reform rules for RCP’s. No update at this time.
4. Rules:
 - a. Resp 100 and Resp 200 hearing anticipated for November.
 - b. Resp 300 hearing anticipated for November
 - c. The Board began working on changes to Resp 400 and will continue that work at the November meeting.

Laws:

- a. RSA 328-F:18 – Allied Health Professionals – adding athletic trainers and genetic counselors to temporary licensure and allowing for an exemption when part of a compact. **Sponsor Representative Schmidt**
- b. RSA 328:18-a Allied Health Professionals – removing conditional licensure while waiting for a background check. **Sponsor Representative Schmidt**
- c. RSA 328-F:19 – Allied Health Professionals – changing the renewal date to two years from the date of licensure. **Sponsor Representative Schmidt**
