Medicaid to Schools – The Board reviewed Governor Sununu’s Executive Order mandating that applications for licensure for those going to work under the Medicaid-to-Schools program be put to the top of the list for review. It was noted that there is no lag time in the processing of applications so this Order will not impact the Allied Health Board’s.

- c. RSA 328-F:19 – Allied Health Professionals – changing the renewal date to two years from the date of licensure. **Sponsor Representative Schmidt**
