STANDING ORDER

APPROVAL PROCESS FOR CONNECTICUT LICENSEES HOLDING A S-1 UNLIMITED HEATING, PIPING AND COOLING CONTRACTOR LICENSE OR A S-2 UNLIMITED HEATING, PIPING AND COOLING JOURNEYMAN LICENSE TO BECOME NEW HAMPSHIRE FUEL GAS SERVICE TECHNICIANS

The Board of Mechanical Licensing (“Board”) has the authority to license applicants, including applicants holding licenses in another state, pursuant to RSA 153:27 through 38 and Saf-Mec 300.

After recent review of Saf-Mec 305.04 and the requirements to become an Unlimited Heating, Piping and Cooling Contractor (“S-1 License”) and an Unlimited Heating, Piping and Cooling Journeyman (“S-2 License”) in Connecticut, the Board finds that the requirements to hold a S-1 or S-2 License in Connecticut are equivalent to the Eligibility Requirements for Initial Individual Fuel Gas Fitter Licensure as a Fuel Gas Technician in Saf-Mec 305.04, except for the requirement that New Hampshire applicants successfully pass the New Hampshire licensing examination.

Therefore, effective immediately and pursuant to Saf-Mec 302.14, Connecticut licensees holding a S-1 or S-2 license, who have applied to become a New Hampshire Fuel Gas Service Technician, shall be approved by the Board Administrator to take the requisite New Hampshire licensing examination. The Board Administrator’s authority is limited to Connecticut S-1 or S-2 licensees who hold an active license in good standing with no pending disciplinary actions.

Connecticut S-1 or S-2 licensees whose applications demonstrate inconsistencies with meeting the requirements of Saf-Mec 305.04, will be reviewed by the Board.


Upon receiving proof of successful completion of the New Hampshire licensing examination, the Board Administrator also has the authority to approve the Connecticut S-1 or S-2 Licensee application to become a New Hampshire Fuel Gas Service Technician.

A list of applicants approved prior to a Board meeting will be provided to the Board at the next available meeting in order for the Board to ratify the licenses.

This standing order shall remain in effect until such time as the order terminates by operation of law or until the Board votes to rescind the order.
