- Be RACE-approved Medical (Category 1) OR given by one of the approved associations listed below.
- Pertain to veterinary medicine.
- Be scientific in nature.

Limitations

- A maximum of 25% of credits may be obtained from RACE-approved Medical journal, distance, or online programs.
- A maximum of 25% of credits may also be obtained in alternative medicine, providing that the programs are RACE-approved Medical.
- RACE-approved Non-Medical programs are not approved to meet CE requirements unless they specifically fulfil opioid or ethics requirements.
